CWF PRISON PROJECT

For the third year in a row, CWF is teaming up with the Philadelphia Department of Prisons to provide the currently incarcerated with our free tax preparation services! This service allows inmates to collect a refund they can share with their families or add to their commissary account. We will be working with 4 prisons in Northeast Philadelphia all located on the same campus on State Road. Volunteers will be doing intake and must be certified to do so.

"Volunteering at the prison is a oneof-a-kind experience. Incarcerated individuals are often unable to access critical resources and it is incredibly rewarding to be able to help them out. The inmates are very kind and appreciative of us being there."
