CWF Host Press Conference with Key Leaders to Announce New IRS Initiative

On Tuesday, July 30th, 2024, CWF hosted Secretary of the Treasury Janet Yellen. PA Governor Josh Shapiro. Congressman Brendan Boyle, and Congresswoman Mary Gay Scanlon to announce the implementation of the IRS's free electronic tax-filing system, **Direct File**, to PA taxpayers next tax season. Direct File is a free, online platform designed to make tax filing more accessible and efficient for all taxpayers.

Following the press conference, CWF President and CEO Dr. Nikia Owens moderated a roundtable discussion featuring Sec. Yellen, Congresswoman Scanlon, City Council Member Rue Landau, representatives from the PA Dept. of Revenue, Ceiba, the City of Philadelphia, and more.

LARYSSA WILSON


